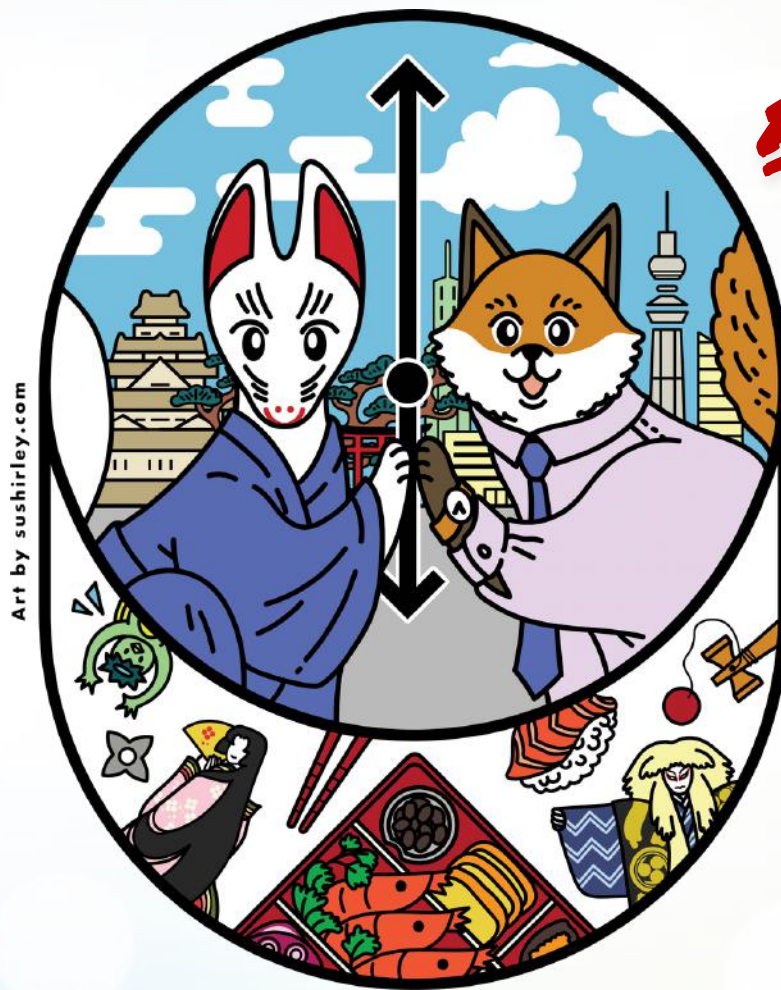

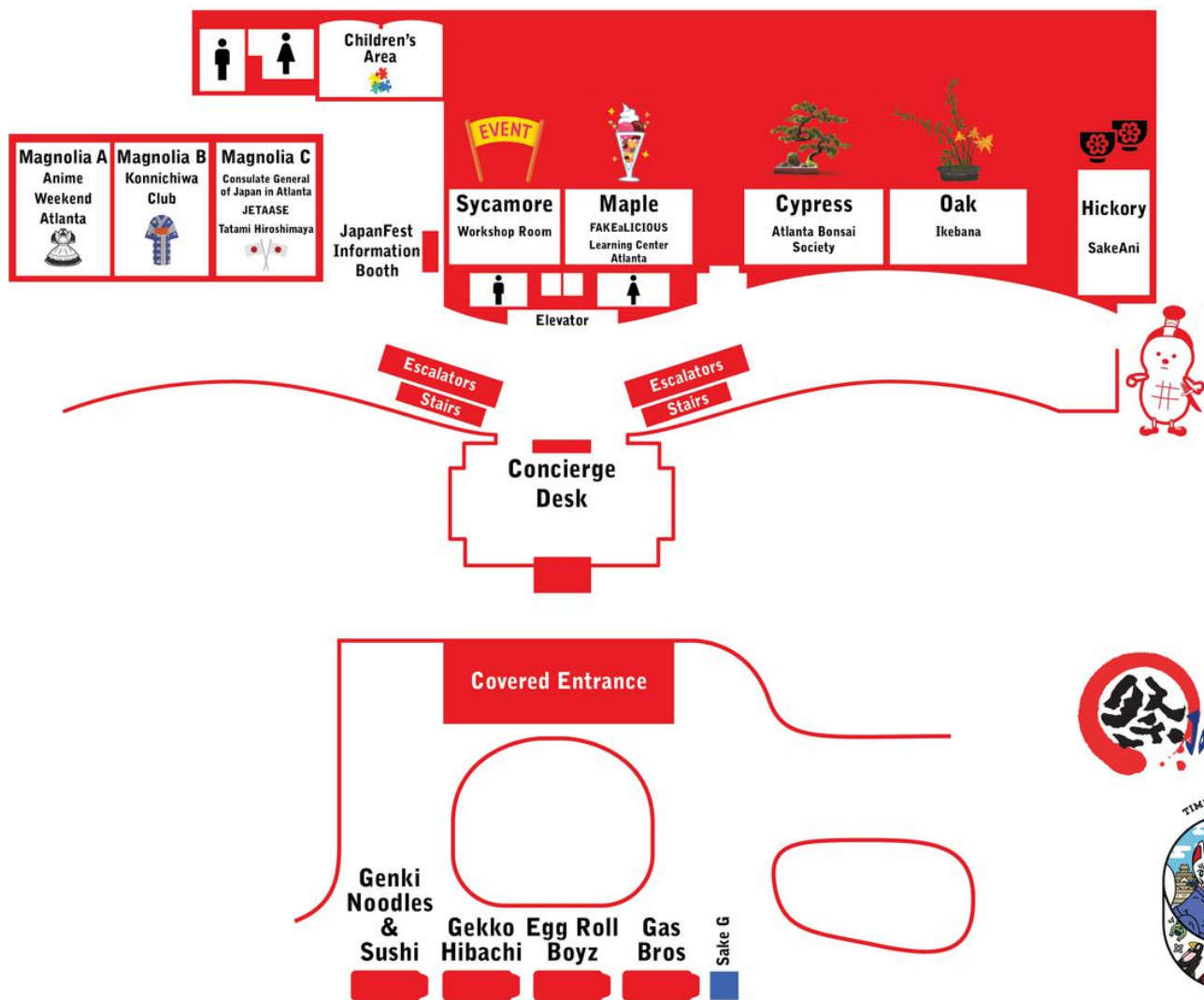


LOCATION MAP

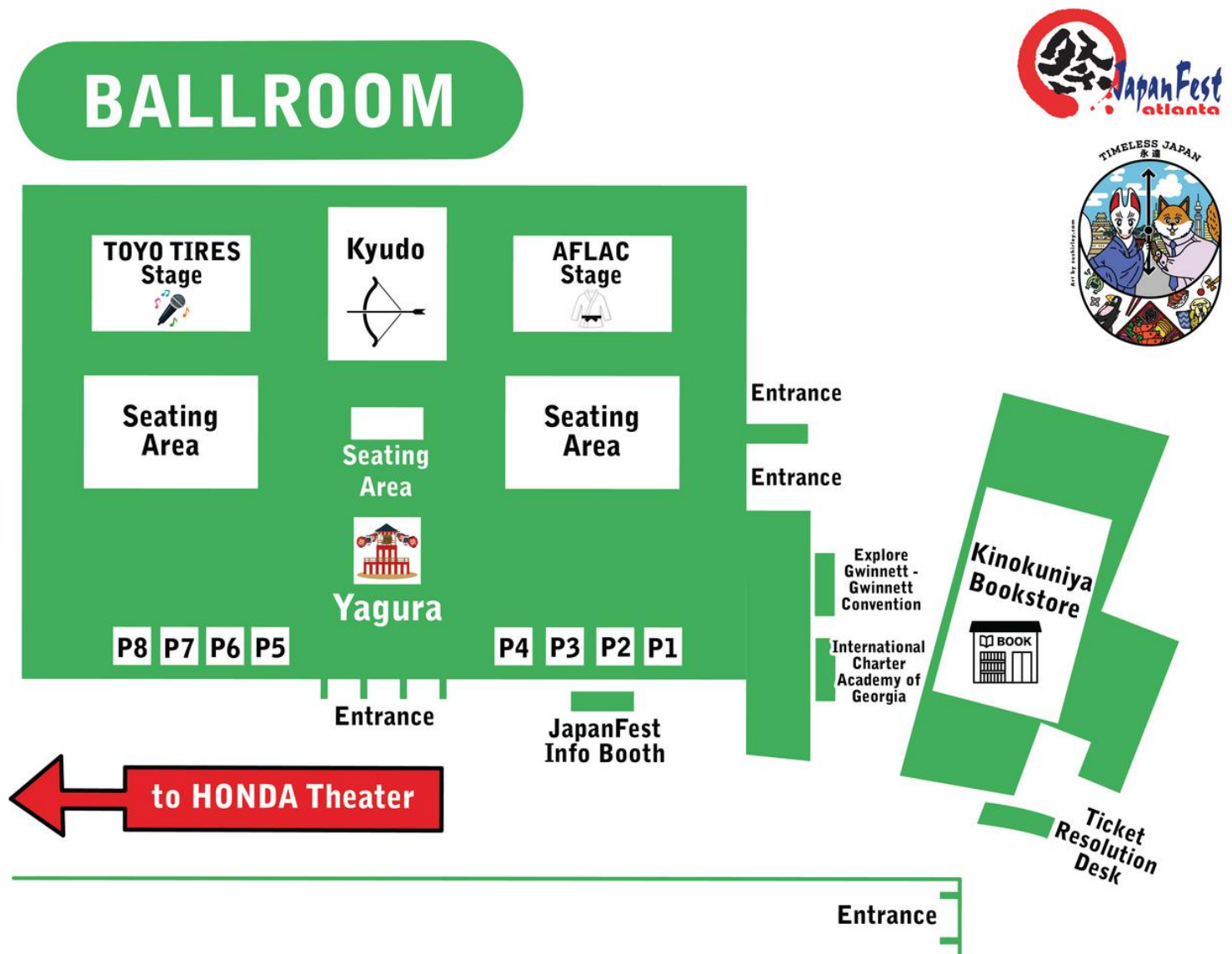
